KCR FEE SCHEDULE

Registration

March 1, 2026 – \$75 one time fee for the summer per family

Tuition:

Plan A – Full-day Program (4-5 days) \$265 weekly

Plan B – Half-day Program (4-5 days) \$195 weekly

Plan C – Single Full-day \$85 a day

Multiple Camper discounts available:

Plan A:

Full Week, Second Child \$195 weekly

Full Week, Third Child + \$135 weekly

Plan B:

Half-Day, Second Child \$145 weekly

Half-Day, Third Child + \$115 weekly

Plan C:

Daily, Second Child \$55 daily

Daily, Third Child + \$40 daily

Before-Care or After-Care Fee of \$20 will be charged for each child per session.

Before-Care: 8:00 AM - 8:50 AM

After-Care: 3:10 PM - 4:00 PM

All payments will be billed and collected through FACTS Management. There is a new family charge of \$50.

Before-Care or After-Care payments will be billed through FACTS Management payment program.

Overdue Balance if your account falls behind, you will be notified about the balance. If it is not resolved, your child's camp attendance will be suspended until your account is current.

Return Drafts or Checks to Kid City Ravenswood for Non-Sufficient Funds will be subject to an additional \$25 service charge.

Guidelines/Student Commitment

Please go over the following guidelines with your child:

I make a commitment to God, myself and the Kid City Ravenswood Summer Camp staff to comply with the following guidelines:

1. I will use my inside voice at summer camp. I understand that this shows self-control and expresses my best character.
2. I will keep my hands, feet and all other body parts to myself. This shows that I respect my friends and Summer Camp family.
3. I will use all furniture in the correct way. This includes desks, chairs, and outdoor equipment. This shows that I respect the Summer Camp property.
4. I will follow instructions, responding the first time I am asked. This reveals my confidence and respect for self and others.
5. I will speak kindly to my friends and Summer Camp staff members. This shows respect for others, myself, and my reputation.
6. When it is time to go home, I will clean up and put away toys and will quickly meet me parent(s). This shows that I care about my program and that I and my parents are supporting each other in learning how to be responsible.

Dress Code

The following guidelines are provided to assist you in making decisions on what to wear to Summer Camp.

1. Please send your child with **extra clothes in a zip locked bag.**
2. ***Children must be fully potty trained.***
3. Shoes must have a back - **NO Flip-flops**
We will have many running activities and flip-flops may cause injury.
4. Please send a water bottle with your child everyday.
5. Please label all of your child's belongings.
6. Please provide your child will ample snacks and lunch.

Attendance

Please go over the following guidelines regarding attendance:

1. Please notify the camp office a head of time regarding any change to pick-up or drop-off.
2. You can pick-up your child at any point throughout the day as needed.
3. Camp ages 3–12 years old. Your child must be fully potty trained to attend.
4. In case of a bathroom accident you may be required to pick your child up or bring a change of clothes.
5. In case of a disciplinary issue you may be required to pick your child up if they do not follow the guidelines.
